NOTES TO APPLICANT

1. AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP- One \$1,200. scholarship is to be awarded to a college undergraduate based upon the following criteria.
2. SELECTION OF WINNERS – Judging will be made by the Scholarship Committee.
3. CRITERIA USED – The following criteria are used as the basis for selecting scholarship recipients.

Professional activities, offices, etc., and work experience on/off campus (employer references recommended)	45 pts.
Grade Point Average (GPA)	30 pts.
Essay on career plans	25 pts.
Recommendation of at least two professors in the applicants major field of study.	0 pts.

4. GPA AND CURRICULUM – Applicants must provide an official transcript of their grades in college including grades from second semester or third quarter. You will be disqualified if a certified copy of your transcript is not submitted with your application.
5. SUBMISSION DEADLINE – Forward all scholarship applications to WV Water Environment Association, P.O. Box 5262, Charleston, WV 25361. All applications must be received by April 1 for consideration.
6. ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS – The announcement of winners will be made by April 15. Applicants not selected will be notified in writing after April 15.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Be a college undergraduate and citizen of the United States.
2. Be a dependant of current Active or PWOD member of the WV Water Environment Association. The Active or PWOD member shall have been a member of the Association for the past three consecutive years.

The essay will be evaluated based upon the clarity of the stated objective, presentation of supporting evidence, clarity of expression, logical consistency, and reasonable freedom from mechanical errors.
